5 Days of Dirt – South Island Adventure

Five days. **1,500+ km**. Over **40 river crossings**. At least **65%** dirt and gravel. This isn't sightseeing - it's South Island's wild backcountry at full throttle.

You'll ride fully loaded, saddle bags packed, into rutted climbs, rocky tracks, and fast-flowing rivers that demand skill, stamina, and grit. Each night ends in a small town where a hot meal and warm shower wait, a hard-earned reward before the next day's punishment.

The routes are locked and loaded, but if the crew wants to push harder or detour, we make it happen. This is your adventure, your fight with the terrain. This is no holiday. It's a test - one that separates riders from warriors.

RIDER DIFFICULTY SCALE



Level 1 – Easy Adventure

Smooth gravel, light dirt. Beginner-friendly.



Level 2 – Intermediate

Gravel roads, some ruts, and a few shallow water crossings. Basic off-road confidence needed.



Level 3 – Advanced

Mixed gravel and dirt with occasional rocky sections and moderate water crossings. Good stamina recommended.



Level 4 – Extreme

Challenging backcountry with mud, steeper climbs, and deeper crossings. Best for riders with solid off-road experience.

SCHEDULE:

ARRIVAL DAY – Christchurch – The Gathering

Pick up from Christchurch Airport and transfer to accommodation. Meet the crew and get ready for the adventure ahead.

DAY 1 – Christchurch to Fairlie – The Long Way Round

245 km | 55% Dirt

Ride backroads and dirt tracks to Fairlie, warming up for the days ahead. Scenic, open, and exhilarating.

DAY 2 – Fairlie to Alexandra – Danseys & Dust

380 km | 65% Dirt

Past Lake Pukaki, through Black Forest Station, and over Danseys Pass into Alexandra. High-country adventure at its best.

DAY 3 – Alexandra Loop – The Obelisk & The Nevis Challenge

310 km | 65% Dirt

Climb The Obelisk, ride Piano Flats, and tackle the epic Nevis Track before returning to Alexandra. Rugged, thrilling, unforgettable.

DAY 4 – Alexandra to Kurow – Riding Through Middle-earth

305 km | 70% Dirt

Traverse Lake Onslow and Moa Creek through landscapes straight out of The Lord of the Rings. Arrive in Kurow ready for the final stretch.

DAY 5 – Kurow to Christchurch – The Last Ride Home

330 km | 60% Dirt

Through Hakataramea Valley and Mackenzie Pass, finishing in Christchurch. Evening group dinner to share highlights and stories.

DEPARTURE DAY – Christchurch – The Farewell

Transfer to Christchurch Airport. Memories of epic trails and high-country landscapes stay with you forever.

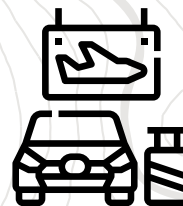

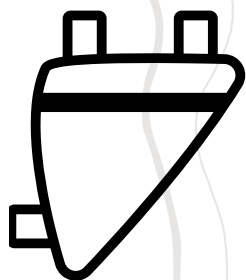

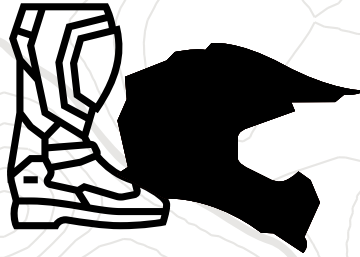

Bookings are accepted with the understanding that the client acknowledges the potential risks involved in motorcycle riding and operating an adventure motorcycle.

Waitotara Valley Estate Ltd, trading as Rumbling Adventures New Zealand, reserves the right to modify or amend the terms and conditions at any time without notice. Any changes will be effective immediately.

"Waitotara Valley Estate Ltd, trading as Rumbling Adventures New Zealand" (hereafter referred to as 'RUMBLING ADVENTURES') and "You" (hereafter referred to as 'RIDER') accept these terms and conditions as a binding contract between Rumbling Adventures New Zealand and yourself.

BOOKING AND CANCELLATION POLICY

1.1 Booking Policy

- All prices are in New Zealand Dollars (NZD).
- A deposit of NZD 1,500 is required to secure a RIDER's spot and confirm motorcycle selection from available models. Deposits are non-refundable and can be made via credit card or bank transfer.
- An invoice for the outstanding balance will be sent to the RIDER, with full payment due 30 days or more before the ride departure date. Payments can be made via bank transfer or credit card.
- Credit card payments incur a 3.3% surcharge.
- If the final payment is not received 30 days before the start of the tour, the deposit will be forfeited, and the booking canceled.
- A bond of NZD 2,500 per motorcycle hire is required at the commencement of the ride. (See insurance terms and conditions.)
- All prices include New Zealand Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 15%.

1.2 Cancellation Policy

1.2.1 Participant Cancellation

- If canceled more than 30 days before the start of the ride, the RIDER will be refunded all payments made, less the non-refundable deposit.
- If canceled within 30 days of the start date, 100% of the ride cost will be forfeited.
- If the RIDER is a no-show at the scheduled start time, 100% of the ride cost will be forfeited.
- We recommend the RIDER obtains personal travel insurance to cover any unforeseen circumstances that might prevent attendance.

1.2.2 Ride Cancellations

- RUMBLING ADVENTURES reserves the right to cancel any scheduled ride at any time due to insufficient participation, severe weather, natural disasters, pandemics, or any other reason.
- In the event of a ride cancellation, RUMBLING ADVENTURES will:
- Notify the RIDER immediately.
- Not be liable for any additional costs or losses incurred by the RIDER due to the cancellation. This includes, but is not limited to, other accommodation reservations, travel costs, and other pre-planned expenses.
- Offer an option to reschedule another ride or provide a refund of the ride deposit and ride balance, less any deposits paid for pre-booked accommodation, activities, and admin fees, which will constitute a full settlement.

2. TOUR REQUIREMENTS

- A full motorcycle license valid for riding in New Zealand, or an international driver's permit, is required.
- The minimum age is 21 years old.
- Our rides are not suitable for beginner riders; RIDERS should have off-road riding experience and be capable of handling a mid-size adventure motorcycle off sealed roads.

3. MOTORCYCLE CHOICE & AVAILABILITY

- RUMBLING ADVENTURES provides the motorcycles for the tour.
- Available motorcycle models will be confirmed at the time of booking.
- Motorcycles are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and your preferred model may not be available at the time of booking.

4. RIDER FITNESS, HEALTH & SAFETY

By entering into a ride contract with RUMBLING ADVENTURES, the RIDER confirms that they are in suitable physical and mental condition to participate without posing a risk to themselves or others. The RIDER:

- Is responsible for riding at their own pace and within their experience level at all times.
- Must not exceed local traffic laws, speed limits, or their riding experience level.
- Is prohibited from exceeding laws in relation to the consumption of alcoholic beverages while operating any vehicle/ motorcycle during a ride, or the taking of ANY drugs that may impair judgement while riding.

5. INSURANCE TERMS & CONDITIONS

5.1 Motorcycle Insurance

Full comprehensive motorcycle insurance is included for motorcycles belonging to RUMBLING ADVENTURES.

5.2 Security Deposit (Bond)

- A bond of NZD 2,500 is required per motorcycle at the start of the ride. This sum is fully refundable if the motorcycle and accessories are returned undamaged. Any damage costs will be deducted from the bond, with the remaining balance refunded. The RIDER's maximum liability is limited to the bond plus any recovery costs. Payments by credit card will incur a 3.3% surcharge.
- The bond must be paid in full by credit card, debit card, cash, or electronic funds transfer and will be held for the duration of the ride.

6. EVENT INFORMATION

RUMBLING ADVENTURES reserves the right to accept or deny any individual from participating. RUMBLING ADVENTURES does not discriminate based on sex, race, or religion. However, RUMBLING ADVENTURES owners, operators, or riding guides may deny continuance of the tour if the RIDER is deemed a danger or disruption to themselves, the group, or the public. Any RIDER denied continuance is responsible for their own accommodation, meals, airport shuttle services, and other incurred costs. No refunds will be issued to any RIDER denied continuance. RUMBLING ADVENTURES reserves the right to cancel a participant's tour and motorcycle rental agreement at any time if it is reasonably believed that the RIDER's driving is negligent, careless, or likely to cause danger.

7. EXTRA FEES & CHARGES

Traffic and/or parking violations during or after the ride are the RIDER's responsibility. These must be paid by the RIDER or will be charged to the RIDER's nominated method of payment.
